

THE SHOW

Aware as the Japanese concept expressing the beauty and the relevance of the ephemeral. A meeting point among theatre, circus, dance and music. Aware brings on stage an experience to connect with fragility, love, fight, tenderness, strength, happiness... These are coming through the relations between the characters who introduce themselves using acrodance, tightrope, Chinese pole or juggling as their languages. Music appears as the nexus, the script of the show to guide and create this story. An eclectic musical section counts with the kora, txalaparta, piano and drumset among others instruments.

More than thirty metres of rope, two poles, four wood planks, eight instruments, seven balls, four interprets and a lot of emotions in a subtle and delicate show.

Technical needs

Flat, not inclined floor

Stage dimensions (adaptable)

11 m width

9 m depth

7 m height

Duration 50 minutes

Aware tours with four artists and a technician (when going to a theatre, the presence of at least a technician from the hosting theatre is required)

Street

Plug connection

Setting-up Time 90 minutes

Warming-up Time 50 minutes

Dismantling Time 90 minutes

TECHNICAL SHEET

ANCHOR POINTS

It is used a structure built up of two chinese poles joined by a rigid piece in the upper part. The distance between the poles is 2m and the structure is placed in the center of the stage.

Needed 4 anchor points creating a rectangle following the distances and parameters of the following figures.

Depending on the space, it might be necessary two extra anchor points (ask the company).


Anchor points

- **Required 4 anchor points creating a rectangle** with a front distance between 10 and 12 meters – depending on the particular space might be necessary other additional anchor points (ask the company)
- Min 500 kg per point, optimal 800kg
- Options:
 - Special prepared anchor points
 - Weights
 - Possible to drill
 - Urban furniture (street)



Set-up with 5 anchor points







THE COMPANY

Alodeyá Circo Danza is born from the eagerness of their components for researching new ways of communicating themselves through the synergism among several, different artistic expressions. By means of poetry, live music, dance and circus, they develop a personal, intimate and extraordinary eloquent language. Stories of ups and downs, love and heartbreak. Stories of powerful contents. Stories of a great visual strength.

The company is created in 2014 with the project of giving shape to “Memories” show. During 2015, this show is awarded twice: Best Show at Zaragoza’s Off and Best Aragón Circus Show. In 2016 the show is programmed in festivals like Umore Azoka in Leioa, Pirineos Sur or Fira Mediterrània de Manresa, spending the last month of the year in the Festival Escenarios Suspendidos in México. Their new production, Aware, gets a research grant from European project De Mar a Mar, opening the company to two new members, Milki and Noche.
