#### **Technical Sheet**

Flat floor, not inclined

#### Performing Stage

- 8 m width
- 7 m depth
- 6 m height

#### Duration 50'

Out of stock tours with one artist and a technician (in theatre, the presence of at least one technician from the host theatre is required)

#### Street


Plug connection Setting-up time 210 minutes Warming-up time 30 minutes Dismantling time 90 minutes

#### Theatre


Setting-up time 360 minutes Warming-up time 30 minutes Dismantling time 90 minutes

#### **Anchor points**

- Needed three points
  - Left anchor point of the figure must be at least at 7m from the pole
  - It is also possible to set it up with four points
- At least 500kg per point
- Optimal 800kg per point
- Options:
  - Previous anchor points
  - Weights, deposits
  - Chance to drill
  - Urban furniture (street)



In the next figures some considerations regarding the pole set-up can be observed with the aim of improving the comprehension for the anchor points distribution



#### Lighting


- 36 Dimmer channels
- 1 programmable control table, with sequence and 24 submasters
- All projectors with leaves and filter holders
- One direct power socket on stage in the right shoulder

PROJECTORS

- 15 PC 1 Kw
- 6 Recortes 1 Kw 15°/32°
- 4 PAR 64 n°5- CP62
- 3 Fresnel 1Kw

#### SOUND

 A boundary microphone similar to a Crown PCC160 is recommended
